FINANCE REPORT

Sue Berry presented the new budget for approval. Karen Miller moved to approve the minutes, the motion was seconded by Jenny Goeglein, and the budget was approved unanimously by voice vote.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Chaperones/Volunteers: *Dorit Askenazy, chair.* The first football game is September 3 and requires parent volunteers.

First Aid: *Need chairperson.* The first aid kit has been supplied for the year.

Fundraising: *Karen Ruthrauff, chair.* Events this year include Tag Day September 12, two car washes, monthly restaurant spirit nights, spirit wear, fruit and cheesecake sale (November). A volunteer is needed to head the fruit and cheesecake sale.

Hospitality: *Ginger Fletcher, chair.* Hospitality events include dinners like tonight, banquets at the end of the marching and concert seasons, and opportunities to feed the students before football games and competitions. Calls for food and volunteers will be made via Sign Up Genius. Parents can be reimbursed for grocery purchases using the form on the website under the EBPO section.

Pit crew: *Need chairperson.* The pit crew needs parent volunteers. No truck is necessary; male and female volunteers are welcome.

Publicity: *Sarah Kolo, chair.* Press release for Tag Day has been shared with chorus to promote the event to the school and the community (Patch).

Spirit Wear: *Jenny Goeglein, chair.* An order form is available; please submit orders by September 11 so that spirit wear will be delivered in time to wear during the season. Some spirit wear is available to purchase now. Items to order include t-shirts, track jackets, lined windbreakers, sweat pants and sweatshirts, and wicking polo shirts.

Tag Day: *Dave and Sarah Kolo, chairs.* All students are needed from 8 am to 5 pm on Saturday, September 12. Several parents are needed to help by driving during the morning or afternoon shifts. We also need a parent volunteer to assist Kat Cook with getting students in uniforms at 8 am. A Sign Up Genius will be coming soon to volunteer. Pizza will be served at school in between shifts. Thank you for your support; this is our largest fundraiser. With enough volunteers, we can raise \$9,000.

Uniforms: *Jenny Goeglein and Kat Cook, chairs.* No report.

BAND DIRECTOR'S REPORT

The first section of the show is on the field and will be performed at the September 3 football game. There are two more sections of the show, but the first is about half the show.
